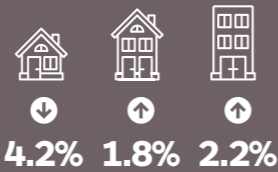

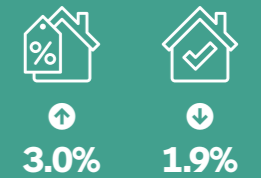
Mandarin has overtaken Italian in top languages other than English spoken, increasing to 2% of the population

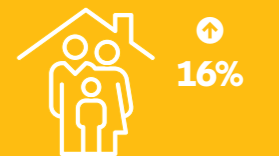
